- Annual budget is about 600 k EUR
- On top, IUPAP has a reserve of about 1.4 M EUR
- Major expenditures per year:
 - Conference support (~30%),
 - Commissions, Working Groups, CC&C (~20%),
 - LAAAMP (~15%),
 - YSP (~4%)
